She puts her own desires and interests above the needs and desires of her son.

- She desires the praise and recognition of highly educated people for her research and published papers.
- She desires the praise and recognition of everyone around her for her employment status.
- To achieve the above two goals she left her son alone at home most of the time and sent him to live with her sister for some times during the summer school vacation.
- She put heavy psychological and emotional pressure on her son to achieve high praise and recognition from people in his school, and in addition to his normal school subjects she demanded that he learn other subjects, such as Mandarin and piano.
- She denied for her son the benefits of daily support and contact with his father. She did this by unilaterally deciding to leave their home in Seattle and demanding that her husband follow her in spite of his objections to give up everything he had there – his career, his children and grandchildren, his friends and the beautiful environment. She issued an ultimatum. Either do what I say or lose your son.
- She put heavy psychological and emotional pressure on him to become a medical doctor or some other profession of similar his status, regardless of what he wanted to do. That was to satisfy her personal happiness to prove that she was such a good mother to make him achieve the things that she appreciated.

She puts her own desires and interests above those of her son's father (ex-husband).

- Her concept of marriage was for her husband to support her in her goals and deny his own needs..
- He had to suffer eight years of loneliness while she was working so hard to get her Ph. D. and Medical Degree.
- She expected him to continue to suffer after he followed her to the East Coast and work as an intern for her four years of Residency, and then after that while she spent so much time doing research.

She denied the time for visitation between the father and son to such a degree that it was impossible for them to make a normal psychological and emotional connection.
